\$275 within one week of camp

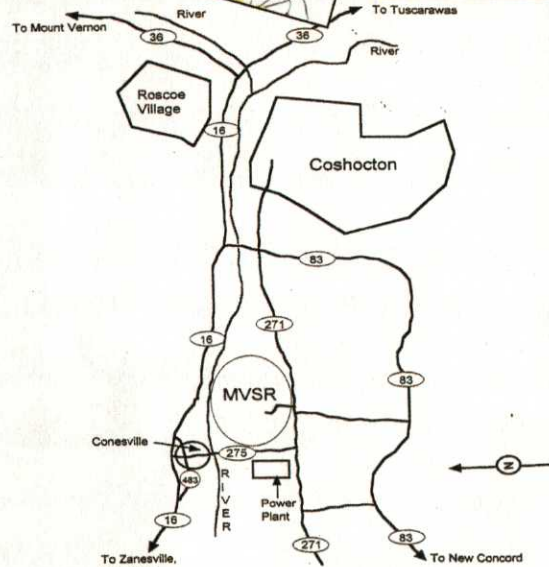
Leader's Fees:

Additional Adult Leaders: Each additional adult leader is \$80.00.

NOTE: Webelos that have crossed over or new Scouts coming into your troop after the May 12th deadline may come to camp for \$235 if paid at the office in advance, otherwise \$250 will be charged at camp.

Specialty Camps:

POWER: \$125 (\$100)*

A special 4 day camp that will focus on energy and natural resources. Participants will complete the



requirements for Mining in Society and Energy Merit Badges. They will also tour the AEP Conesville plant and the Three Rivers ethanol plant.

MVSX: \$165 (\$115)*

This is a 5 day canoe float trip that begins at Mohican State Park and ends at Camp. It also includes the high ropes course at Mohican Adventures.



Participants will earn the 50 Miler Award.

BSA Lifeguard: \$125 (\$100)*

Become a professionally trained lifeguard during this 7 day rigorous course.



Participants must be strong swimmers and proficient in the use of canoes and rowboats.
